Good afternoon

I refer to the request for feedback in relation to the [Updates to Reserved Names List](#).

Can we also request that consideration is given to reserving relevant domains at the state government level?

An example of this is 'police.qld.gov.au'.

Because other Australian states have an equivalent domain, such as police.nsw.gov.au, police.wa.gov.au and so on, there is potential for name collisions if each state wishes to secure the domain 'police.au'.

Some further examples of 2<sup>nd</sup> level domain names to reserve would be:

- a. education.au
- b. educationdepartment.au / departmenteducation.au / educationdept.au / depteducation.au
- c. school.au / schools.au
- d. teacher.au / teachers.au
- e. eq.au
- f. qschool.au / qschools.au, qparent.au / qparents.au, qteacher.eq / qteachers.au, qstudent.au / qstudents.au
