What is .au direct?

- Launched 24 March 2022
- Greater choice of names in .au:
 - Shorter, more memorable names
 - Names that are easier to type and display on mobile devices (such as auDA.au)
 - Keeping pace with community expectations and technology


Growth of the .au domain

- Strong growth continues in .au
 - Nearly 4.2 million .au domain names
- au is now the seventh largest country code Top-Level Domain (ccTLD) and sits just outside the top ten TLDs
- 30,200 queries per second to the .au
 domain name system (DNS)






au direct registrations

- More than 720,000 registrations
- Analysis from October 2022 data (137,000 registrations) showed:
 - 58 per cent companies
 - 16 per cent sole traders
 - 12 per cent incorporated associations
 - 7 per cent citizens
 - 7 per cent other



What's being registered?

- 43,741 .au direct names are dictionary words compared to 52,644 com.au names
- In context:
 - A person needs about 8,000 to 9,000 word
 vocabulary to read books and newspapers
 - A native English speaker will have around
 20,000 to 35,000 word vocabulary



Priority Allocation - contentions

- Priority Allocation: six month period following launch (24 March – 20 September 2022 UTC time)
- Most applicants were successful and received their .au direct names
- 6,223 names still in contention as of end of Jan
 2023
 - More than 457,000 contentions resolved through Priority Allocation



Contentions

- 13,832 applications for 6,223 contended names
- Top domains are generic terms, e.g.
 - Transport.au
 - Skills.au
 - Business.au
- Contentions renew on 20 September 2023
 - Applicants need to remain eligible



Renewals

- Renewal date is determined by:
 - Length of licence
 - Date of registration
- Names allocated through Priority
 Allocation have a one-year licence
- Domains can be renewed 90 days before expiry
- Registrars will contact you directly about renewals


